Designing a Connection System

- 1. Measurable factors of connecting.
 - Regular worship attendance
 - Development of 5 to 10 new friends
 - Participation in a small group
 - Identifiable role in the church
 - Consistent giving percentage
 - Referring to the church as "my church"

2. Areas to look at...

- First Impressions (being guest-friendly)
- S Greeter System−1st line of defense
- S Hospitality System—2nd line of defense (welcome center, hosts)
- Intentional Friendliness System—3rd line of defense (worship center zone greeters, leadership greetings)
- Guest follow-up (getting names, delivering gift, phone calls, letters, get-acquainted packet, 2nd & 3rd week strategy)
- Newcomer orientation (becoming acquainted with our church ministries & our people; digital pictorial directory)
- Shepherding system (leaders overseeing everyone in church so we can catch when people may be on verge of dropping out or needing special care)
- Tracking system (ensuring people don't fall through the cracks)
- System for getting new people into small groups
