Stories of Hope

- Facilitator tells the story from memory, best they can.
- Facilitator asks those in the group to repeat the story, best they can. Some can tell part of the story then pass it on to the next person to tell a part, etc until the story is completed.
- Pray a SHORT PRAYER asking the Holy Spirit to guide and teach us the truth about the story *(with explorers this can be optional)*
- Read the story from the Bible, from one or two different translations (*with explorers this can be optional*)

Good Stories to Use with Explorers

A simple way to remember the Cross Questions:

- 1. The Cross points up, reminding me to ask, "What does this story say about Jesus or God?"
- 2. The Cross points down, reminding me to ask, "What does this story say about people?"
- 3. One thief mocked Jesus, reminding me to ask, "Are there any sins to avoid?"
- 4. The other thief confessed his sins, reminding me to ask, "Are there any good examples to follow?"
- 5. Jesus gave the confessing thief a promise, reminding me to ask, "*Are there any promises in this story?*"
- 6. Since Jesus died a death he didn't deserve, for me, I am reminded to ask, *"Who in this story reminds me of myself and why?"*
- 7. Wrap Up Question: "What would I need to do to obey or live out this story?"
